Corporal Work of Mercy: Clothe the Naked

Definition:

Helping either directly or indirectly to assist others to obtain adequate clothing through donation or purchase.

Examples:

Offering some of your own clothing (not just excess) for people who need it. Volunteering for the St. Vincent de Paul Society. You can lend something to a friend for a special occasion. You can also restrain yourself from an unnecessary purchase and give the money to an agency that helps people in need of clothing.

Definition:

Generosity is NOT philanthropy out of our surplus wealth or government welfare programs. Generosity involves our personal sacrifice, and it is sacrificial to our way of life.
