Capital Virtue: Chastity

<u>Definition:</u> Chastity not only moderates our desire for physical acts of sexual pleasure, but also helps us to redirect the thoughts which precede these impure actions. It respects sexual union as a gift for marriage.

Examples: When I see an attractive person, I keep my focus on their face/eyes. When I choose clothes, I don't wear tight, low cut clothes that make it easier for others to see me as an object rather than a beloved child of God.

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Confirmation Name Report

Write a one page report on your Confirmation name (this name will be used by the bishop when he anoints you.) This can be typed or handwritten on a separate sheet.

The report will need to include:

- Why you chose this name (maybe your baptismal name, a family name, a new name you chose to claim your Christian identity, a patron saint name...)
- How this name will make a lasting difference for you
- Information about the saint whose name you are using. Both baptismal and confirmation names need to come from the Christian tradition.

CCC 2156 - In Baptism, the Lord's name sanctifies man, and the Christian receives his name in the Church. This can be the name of a saint, that is, of a disciple who has lived a life of exemplary fidelity to the Lord. The patron saint provides a model of charity; we are assured of his intercession. The "baptismal name" can also express a Christian mystery or Christian virtue. "Parents, sponsors, and the pastor are to see that a name is not given which is foreign to Christian sentiment."
