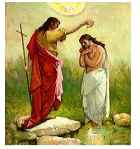

Capital Virtue: Diligence

Definition:

Diligence is the virtue that tells us to fulfill our duties in life, even if they get to be tiresome. These duties include our work, our home, our country, our church, and our families. It enables us to carry out our responsibilities – both civic and religious.
